

### New Business

#### Discussion of Goshen Bicentennial Celebration in 2019

Mr. Haas stated that he hopes to have a bicentennial discussion on the second Board of Trustee Meeting night each month at 6:30PM. He has discussed some celebration ideas with the other committee members, such as a Founder's Day Dinner with a guest speaker on Saturday, 3/16/19, in a location close to Goshen, such as O'Bannonville Golf Course, or the Oasis Conference Center. He stated that the committee also wants to have some events between March, and throughout the summer weekends, that would appeal to multiple age groups.

Trustee Hausermann recommended a Grand Finale at the end of the summer. Trustee Hodges has contacts for amusement rides. Trustee Hausermann also relayed the interest in a fireworks display by members of the public.

Mr. Haas inquired about what contributions could be made by the township, as there are fundraiser events in the works, but additional help will be needed. Trustee Hausermann stated that the township could add an event to its insurance policy, and can be budgeted for in Contributions to Organizations.
